To enable the school to maximise the quality of the learning program for students requires the provision of resources and activities. The provision of these resources and activities is, in part, met by voluntary contributions and charges. These voluntary contributions and charges are permitted by the Education Act and approved by the School Board. Your support in payment of voluntary contributions and charges benefits students and is sincerely appreciated.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS:

The total amount of voluntary contributions parents and carers are being asked to give has been contained within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the areas listed below. The actual costs per child are shown in the table beneath. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution.

CHARGES :

A breakdown of **estimated charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities, etc. has been included in the schedule below. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as the date of the activity draws near.

The charges schedule includes costs associated with -

- specific learning activities are available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made. e.g. incursions, excursions, etc.
- specific learning activities are available to **selected** students, but conditional on a payment being made. e.g. PEAC, School of Instrumental Music program, etc.
- other activities available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made. e.g. interm swimming classes.
- P & C Information and Communication Technology voluntary approved request of \$35 (pp-6) and \$20 (Kindy) is to support the provision of computer hardware and software and the interactive white board program for students from K to Year 6.

- Charges listed reflect a maximum amount as far as can be estimated at this stage. Charges may be less.
- Payment is prior to a particular activity.
- Attendance at these activities is **optional**. No payment indicates non-participation.

ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE:

The charge for **personal use items** (book lists/stationery lists) will vary from student to student and includes:

- Requirements for all students and used in lessons – e.g. stationery items, calculator etc.
Note: You may be required to replace items such as pencils during the year.
- Requirements recommended and used to assist all students – e.g. art shirt, tissues, library bag etc.
- Students in Yr's 3 – 6 are invited to utilise their own iPad at school providing it meets minimum school specifications - please refer to the Personal Items list and BYOD Guidelines available on the parent portal section of the school website for details: www.sorrentops.wa.edu.au . If families choose to purchase a device then it is important that it meets the school's network requirements.

The recommended list of materials will be forwarded to you as soon as the final list is received from the supplier. **You are not obliged to use our supplier.**

Other charges for personal items include –

- School photos
- Graduation related activities eg graduation shirt
- Book club

Involvement in these activities is at parent discretion.
